



Nurse-Family Partnership Alignment with Illinois Early Learning Guidelines

Overview:

Nurse-Family Partnership uses a variety of materials that address the content areas outlined in the Illinois Early Learning Guidelines. The Nurse-Family Partnership model has developed over 700 Facilitators in the Pregnancy, Infancy, and Toddler phases of program delivery. Each facilitator includes detailed guidelines that assist the nurse home visitor with the content to use with the family. NFP has also incorporated the Partners in Parenting Education (PIPE) curriculum as an additional tool in the model. NFP also uses Keys to Caregiving and NCAST materials. NFP researched tested and validated the use of a dyadic assessment (DANCE) within the model and developed corresponding appropriate interventions (DANCE STEPS) for the nurse home visitors to use to strengthen and promote growth in the areas identified in the dyadic assessment. Finally, NFP uses several screens related to content in the Illinois Guidelines. These include the PHQ9 and Edinburgh for maternal depression and the Ages and Stages Questionnaire and Ages and Stages Social and Emotional Questionnaire for infant and child development. Registered Nurses are skilled in the assessment of mothers, infants, and toddlers and assisting the family with areas of need or developmental growth for the child and referring for specialized services outside the scope of practice of the RN when indicated.
